Discussion was held on hiring Brad Benge on a temporary basis. Motion by Doree to hire Brad Benge, second by Culp, all aye, motion carried. Brad Benge will have to go through the application process for the laborer position.

Motion by Doree to set the wage at \$22.02 for Brad Benge, second by Potts, all aye, motion carried.

Discussion was held on changing the authorization process for all permits. The public works department will authorize with an option for an appeal process. Ryan Mitchell will write the city ordinance and city code.

Discussion was held on Cardinal Community School District waste water service line to Eldon. Following discussion, consensus of the council was not to allow access to Eldon's waste water system until the lagoon project is complete. Discussion was held on the installation of a flow meter. The meter shall be installed. Ryan Mitchell will contact the school regarding these issues.

Motion by Showman to authorize \$550.00 to camera 1<sup>st</sup> and Elm intersection and 2<sup>nd</sup> and Elm intersection, second by Doree, all aye, motion carried.

Motion by Potts to adjourn, second by Bedford, all aye, motion carried.
